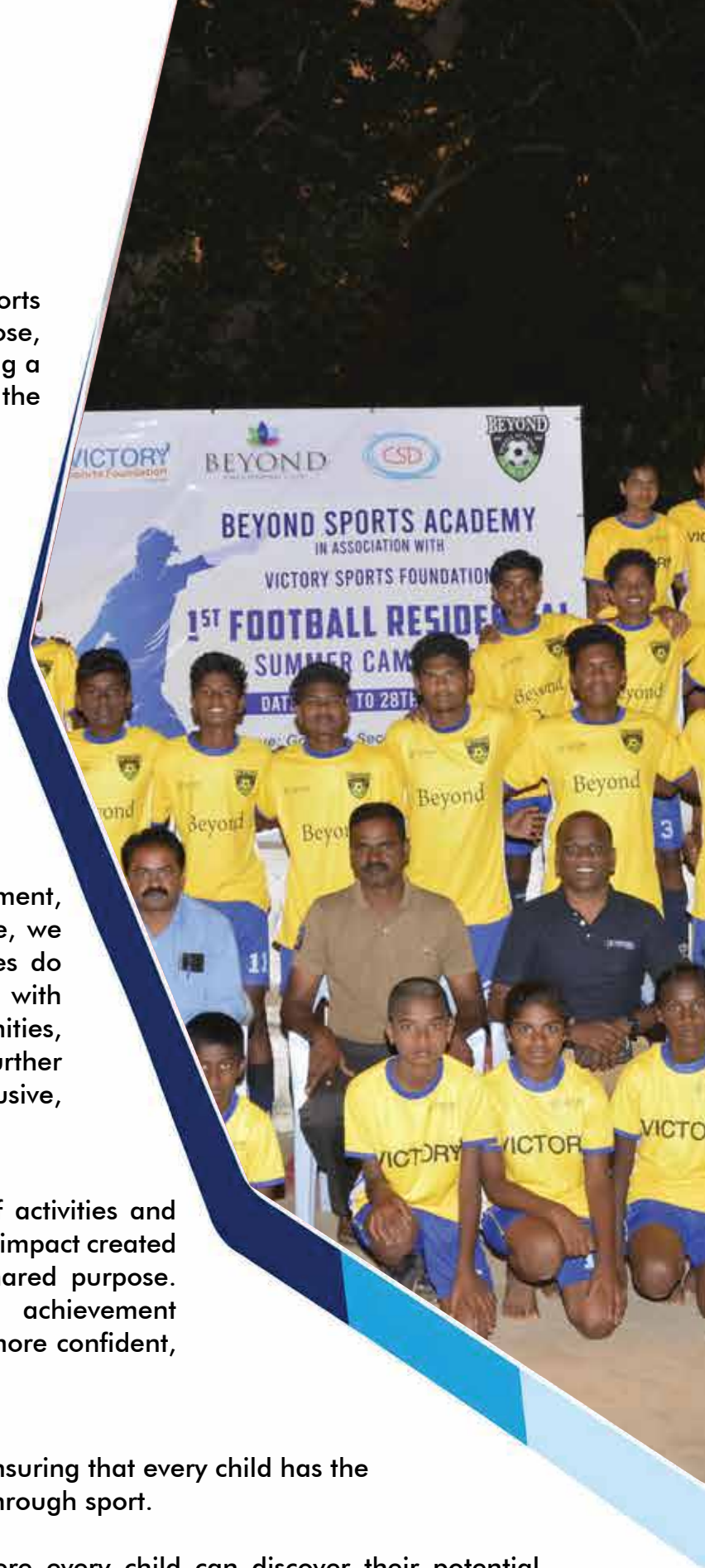

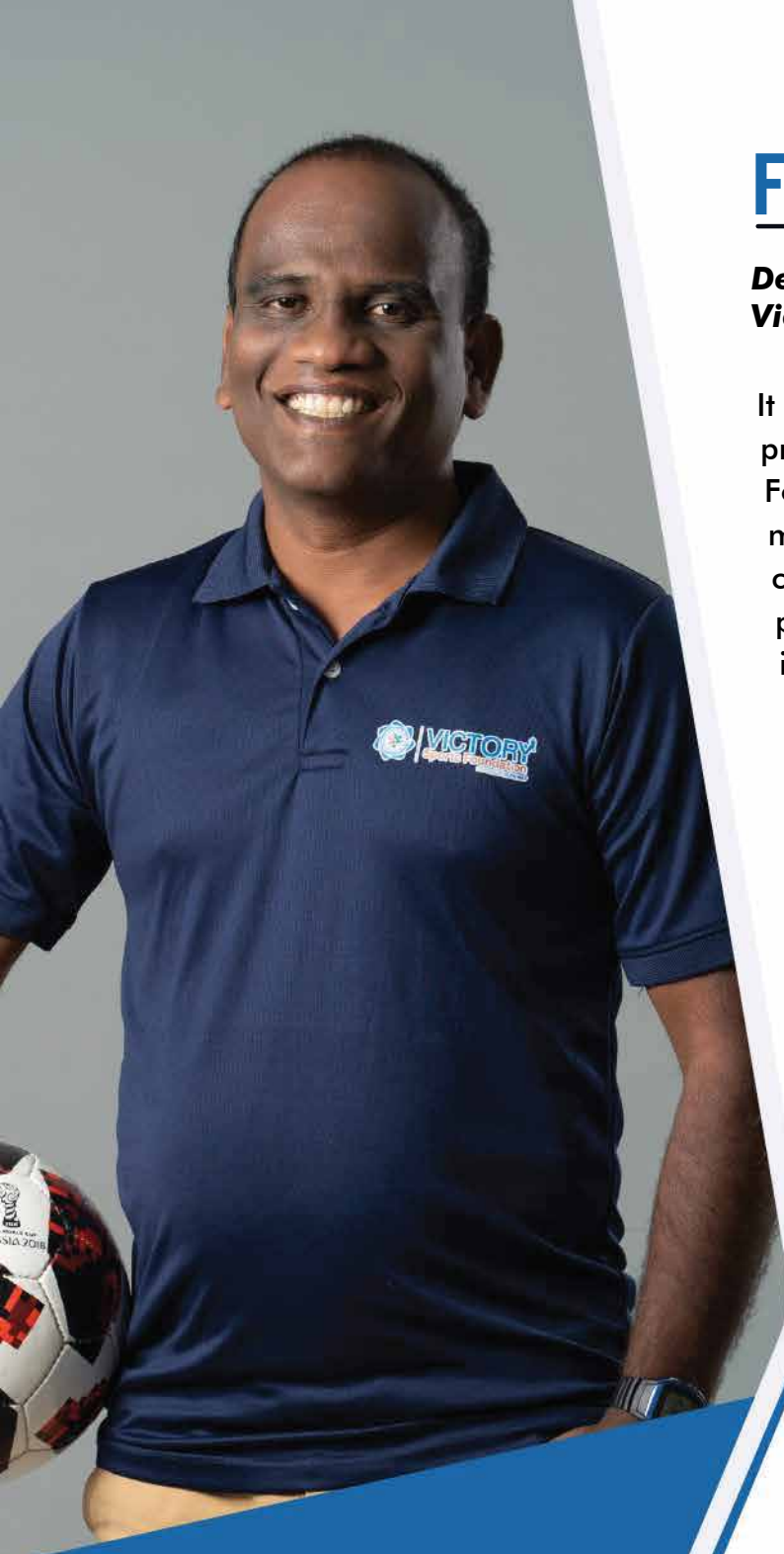

Sports for a Cause

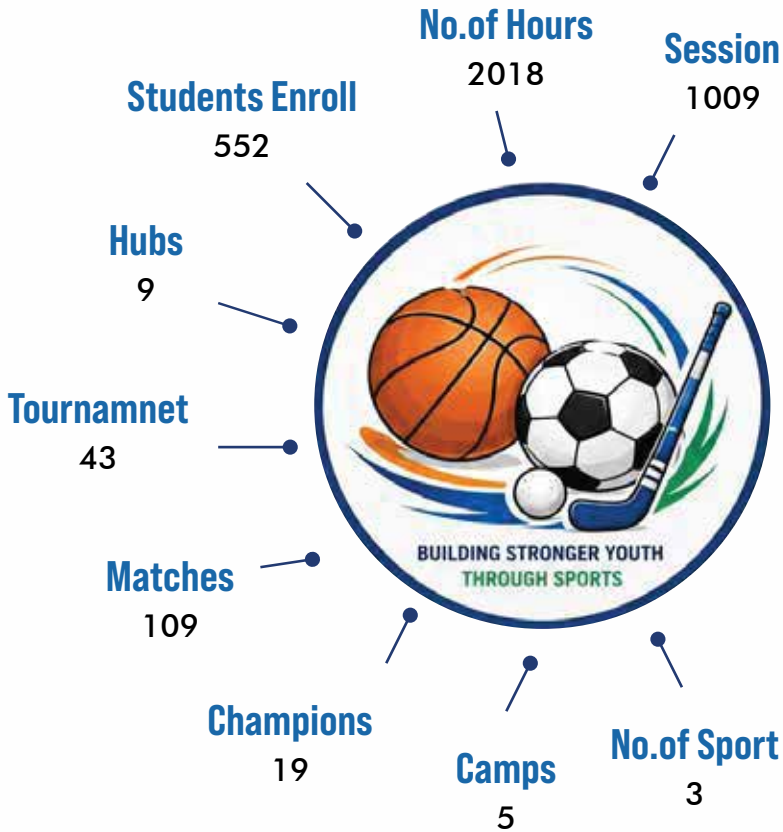

Basketball Summer Camp

Basket Ball Camp at Hindu School

In May 2023, Hindu Hr. Secondary School, an institution with a rich cultural heritage and notable alumni such as Mr. R. Venkattraman and Mr. Kamal Hasan, revived its sporting legacy by collaborating with Victory Sports Foundation, Kaleesuwari Foundation, and other key members. The initiative involved refurbishing the basketball court to its former glory, rekindling a sport that had thrived at the school until 2001. On May 1st, a summer training camp commenced, attended by 38 out of 43 enthusiastic students, nourished with nutritious meals throughout the 20-day program. The camp's concluded by marking the distribution of jerseys, shorts, and sports kits to all participants, acknowledging the collaborative efforts of the school authorities, alumni association, and Kaleesuwari Foundation. This event featured Under-10 and Under-13 league matches, showcasing the participation of three teams in the Under-10 category and four teams in the Under-13 category. This event holds great importance throughout Asia, especially for nurturing grassroots talent. Yelagiri Hills Trophy

"The 1st Yelagiri Hills Trophy, organized by Victory Sports Foundation and Govt. Hr. Sec. School in Athanvoor, took place on July 8th and 9th, 2023, at the Govt. Hr. Sec. School in Athanvoor. The football tournament featured a 5-a-side league cum knockout format for the Under-17 category, with a total of 10 teams participating, divided into two pools: Pool A and Pool B. STEP Tournaments 2023: Victory Sports Foundation successfully organized a series of STEP Tournaments in 2023 to promote grassroots football and basketball among young athletes. The 7th STEP Tournament, held on 15 July 2023 at Chaos Entertainment, featured Under-10 and Under -13 football categories with 56 participants, where K7 FC won the Under-13 title and FC Marina emerged as Under-10 champions. The 8th STEP Tournament, conducted on 16 July 2023 at The Hindu Higher Secondary School, Chennai, was a basketball competition featuring 4 teams, with Santhome emerging as champions and Wesley as runners-up. The 10th STEP Tournament, held on 6 August 2023, brought together 60 participants across 4 teams, with PAK Palanisamy winning the championship and Don Bosco Peravallur finishing as runners-up. The 11th STEP Tournament, organized from 20–23 August 2023, attracted 120 participants in the Under-14 and Under-17 categories, where Don Bosco Peravallur secured the Under-14 title and Savitri Ammal Orientation School finished as runners-up.
